

AMI-X

1. If the district needs to be out for an extended period of time due to COVID, we will employ intermittent blended learning so that your child can still receive education from the safety of their home. Communication will be through the Remind text alert system.
2. Full time staff will be at the school for 20 hours per week, and will be accessible to their students/parents for questions, clarification, and feedback from 8:00-3:00 Monday through Friday. Part time staff, including bus drivers, will be required to fulfill duties as well.
3. Teachers will provide electronic/web based activities through Google Classroom for those who indicated on their registration forms that they have proper internet access at home. The district will check out Chromebooks/laptops to students as needed.
4. Currently, all teachers are to set aside two days per week in which they provide a majority of their assignments/lessons through the Google Classroom platform. This is so they may instruct and educate your children how to access and use the platform so all parties are properly prepared in the event that we have to be out of school for an extended period of time. Here is a “Parents Guide to Google Classroom in 2020” video link which gives a brief overview of the platform. There are many helpful tutorials available on the internet, and of course you may also ask your child’s teacher for assistance.

5. Teachers will provide paper packets/worksheets for those who indicated on their registration forms that they do not have proper internet access at home.
6. For students who require paper packets, we will provide consistent packet drop off and pick up times which will be communicated to our families if/when the need arises. Our bus drivers will drop off and pick up the packets. Teachers will also make phone calls during the week as a means to keep the student/teacher connection and relationship ongoing.
7. For students who require paper packets, we will provide a schedule for the transfer of packets if/when the need arises. Families will also have the option to drop off the completed packets and pick up the new packets at the school. We will provide a schedule for this if/when the need arises.
8. Google Classroom and paper packet students will receive a zero for any incomplete assignments.
9. Goals and objectives of Individualized Education Plans and 504 Plans will be implemented in both paper packets and Google Classroom assignments for all applicable students.

Hardeman teachers will closely follow DESE’s recommendations for daily instructional time for distance instruction (see AMI page)
